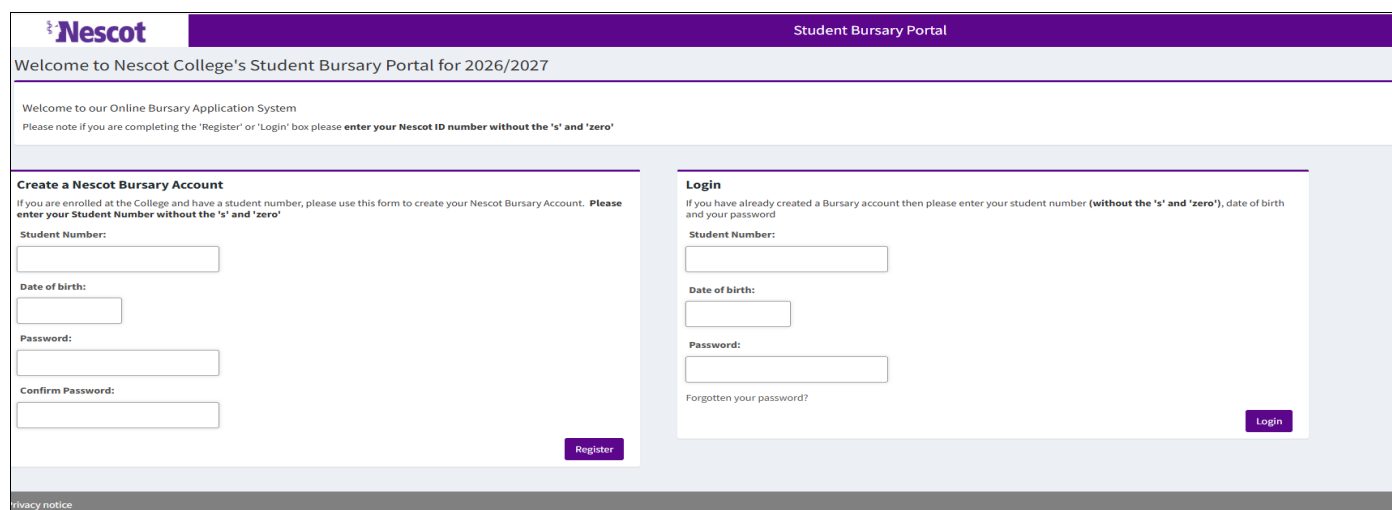
Already have a bursary or free college meals account, before you reapply
