
Where is Nescot?

The borough has plenty of green open spaces, from the compact and historic Bourne Hall in Ewell to the 250-acre Nonsuch Park on the borough's borders.

Epsom is also host to the famous Derby, billed as the world's greatest flat race, which has been a fixture of the horse racing calendar

since the inaugural race in 1780 and which attracted 154,000 people to Epsom Downs in 2016.

International students

Over the last four years, 44% of students enrolling on our Higher Education courses have been mature students. Whether you're starting a new career, changing jobs or adding to your professional qualifications, we work hard to help you balance your studies with your other commitments so that you reach your full potential.



A 'full-time' course doesn't necessarily mean you'll be in college five days a week. Timetables vary between courses, but we aim to schedule classes, tutorials, lectures and assessments in a way that helps you manage your time efficiently.
