

Important message from the University of West London: Two-week extension

Dear Student,

We know that studying at this time is difficult for many students, particularly for those who are also dealing with additional pressures at home.

The University of West London has been listening to student feedback to look at what we can do make life 'a little easier' at this time. Having consulted with our Students' Union, we have decided to extend all assessment or assignment dates by two weeks.

This additional time is available for you should you need it. It is not something you need to apply for, and we would encourage you to hand-in your assessments or assignments earlier than this date, if you are able to.

This extension will apply to all assessments or assignments due from 27 March until 4 September. If you have already submitted a piece of work, you will be able to resubmit it should you wish to. Existing regulations around extension and mitigation will still be applicable.

Your Course Team will be updating their systems and UWL is updating the UWL Blackboard to reflect these changes by Tuesday 14 April.

In response to this news, Ancha Joof, VP Activities and Participation at UWL Students' Union (UWLSU) has said:

"UWLSU welcomes the decision to grant these extensions, giving students a better chance to succeed on their course and taking the pressure off during this stressful time. This kind of decision shows how UWL consistently puts students' needs first, which makes me proud to be part of the UWL community."
